As well as the Schottlander Oral and Poster prizes which are awarded every year at our annual conference, this year we also awarded a President's prize and Early Practitioner Prize. Over 40 abstracts were submitted and the standard as usual was very high.

The winners were as follows:

The Schottlander Oral prize was awarded to Joanne Beaumont from Leeds Dental institute for her presentation "Patient information software for head and neck oncology patients"

The Schottlander poster prize was awarded to Professor Du-Hyeong Lee from Kyungpook National University for his poster entitled "Fit accuracy of interim crown fabricated by photopolymer jetting 3D printing technology"

The President's Poster Prize was awarded to Elizabeth King from Morrision Hospital in Swansea for her poster "Orofacial rehabilitation with Zygomatic implants, CAD-CAM bar and magnets for patients with nasal cancer after rhinectomy and partial maxillectomy".

The Early Practitioner Poster Prize was awarded to Amarjeet Chaggar, Yee Hsiong Khoo and Zahid Shaikh from NE London Deanery for "A service evaluation on tooth restorability".

At our conference dinner, Hannah McCall from the University of Liverpool was awarded the Heraeus Kulzer undergraduate prize for her critical review "Tooth Longevity: What factors should you take into consideration when planning to restore a maxillary incisor with a full coverage crown".

Professor Harold Presikel from King's College London was awarded the BSSPD Gold Medal. This is the highest accolade which the BSSPD awards. This award is presented only once every three years to an individual who has made 'exceptional contributions to the furtherance/development of Prosthodontics' in the following domains: clinical, research, education.
